Introduction

Wyndmere Public School is a fully accredited K-12 North Dakota public school currently educating 219 students in a district which spans approximately 300 square miles. This year will mark its 101st graduation. As of 2016, Wyndmere Public School serves 123 students in grades kindergarten through sixth and 96 students in grades seventh through twelfth. Enrollment is expected to remain relatively steady over the next few years. Our student population consists of 92.5% White, 6% Hispanic/Latino, 1% Native American, and .5% Asian.

Wyndmere Public School employs 3 full-time administrators (an elementary principal, a high school principal, and a superintendent), 27 certified instructional staff, and 33 non-certified employees. Upon entering the school, students, faculty, and guests are greeted with an updated, well-maintained facility with remodeled hallways, locker rooms, bathrooms, and entrances. An established, integrated technology approach has enhanced curriculum within every grade; this includes a Smartboard in each classroom as well as a 1:1 ipad/laptop for students in kindergarten through twelfth grade. High expectations and effective, data-driven practices have earned our district many acknowledgements and awards including the following: The National Blue Ribbon Schools Program Award, MSN's Best School District in North Dakota, North Dakota's Principal of the Year (Elementary and Secondary), North Dakota's Title I Teacher of the Year, K12 Niche's Top North Dakota Teachers, and Top Math and ELA Scores for the Smarter Balance North Dakota State Assessment.

To further meet the needs of our students, Wyndmere Public School belongs to the following organizations:

- South Valley Special Education: accommodates individualized special education services for all elementary and secondary school students including those who require pre-school services.
- Southeast Region Career and Technical Center: provides job entry skills and exclusive opportunities through classes in career and technical education for secondary students located at the SRCTC Wahpeton campus.
- Greater Southeast Interactive TV Consortium: digitally consolidates high school and college level classes through fiber optic 2-way interactive monitors.

Wyndmere District 42 is located in Richland County near the southeast corner of North Dakota and is home to 429 residents. The school also extends its services to the surrounding towns of Barney and McLeod.

- Flex -time in grades 7-12 has been created to allow additional interventions with students, additional homework time, and a time where students are connected to a staff member each day.

- We are continually looking for ways we can reach our struggling students to help them with organizational skills, communication skills, and areas of academic need.
- o We have set as one of our primary goals as oral communication which will also help us strive and focus on improvement
- o Student engagement is an area we area always looking to improve upon
- Parent-involvement is another goal we hope to improve upon as there is a strong correlation between parent-involvement and student success.
